Kaiken Mai 2010 received 93 points in the latest tasting of Argentinean wines by Luis Gutierrez, Wine Advocate taster for Argentina, Chile and Spain.

For his report called "Argentina 2015: One Step Beyond", Gutierrez tasted over 1.000 wines. In his words: "The tastings showed me that more and more producers are following the path toward fresher, less-ripe, concentrated, sweet and oaky wines. Wines are becoming more location-specific to show that not everything is the same and that the grape variety is not the only difference"
