



KAIKEN Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2004 / Argentina

This intense ruby- red wine holds concentrated notes of black fruits such as blackberries and blackcurrants, cassis and a delicate vanilla bouquet emanating from wood. The presence of fruits is flawlessly integrated. Soft, round and seductive tannins provide a distinguishable structure. Its mouthfeel is long, silky and inviting.

Denomination of Origin:
Mendoza, Argentina.

Grape Variety:
*Cabernet Sauvignon 90%.
Malbec 10%.*

Yield of Vineyard:
9 tons per hectare.

Oak Aging:
*70% American oak aging for 6-8 months.
30% unexposed to wood.*

Filtering:
Gently filtered to preserve the wine's original aroma.

Total Production:
Approximately 12.000 boxes

Cellaring Recommendations:
It may be enjoyed immediately or stored for up to 7 years.

Recommended Serving Temperature:
*Recommended 30 minutes decanting before drinking.
17° to 18°C.*

An excellent companion to mature, strong cheese, red and white meats as well as pasta with mild- sauces.
