Mendoza, Argentina.

Malbec 90%.  
Cabernet Sauvignon 10%.

9 tons per hectare.

70% aged in American Oak barrels for 6 to 8 months.  
30% unexposed to wood.

**Filtering:**  
Gently filtered to preserve the wine's original flavor.

**Total Production:**  
Approximately 12.000 boxes

It may be enjoyed immediately or stored for up to 7 years.

16° to 18° C.
